

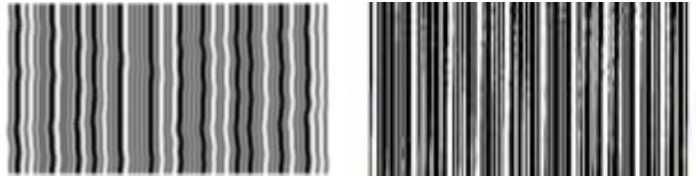
Printing Your Barcoded Tags

The print quality of your barcode is very important since it can greatly impact the speed at which cashiers are able to scan items for a shopper.

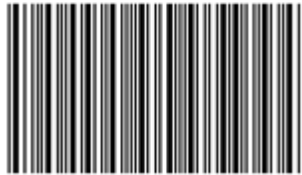
1. Print tags using the normal setting on your printer, not best quality.
2. Make sure your pop-up blocker is off.
3. In your printer settings, print in landscape not portrait.
4. We suggest using Firefox or Internet Explorer as your browser.
5. 8 tags should print to a page.
6. Please print a test page to see how your barcodes look. See the examples below.



If it looks like this one, replace your ink cartridge with a **new** one & align your replacement cartridge.



If it looks like one of these barcodes, realign your current ink cartridge and try again.
